Purpose	Construction and biodiversity are often seen as being at odds with each other. The process of building roads, bridges, and buildings often involves the alteration or destruction of natural habitats, which can have negative impacts on local flora and fauna. This policy aims to mitigate these impacts and enhance biodiversity through careful planning and design.
Aspects	<p>BPTP recognises the long-term benefits of biodiversity preservation for both our companies and society as a whole. We acknowledge that our entities have a significant impact on environment due to human activities. At BPTP, we strive to adopt a proactive strategy to protect the environment by aligning with the Biodiversity management framework of the Convention On Biological Diversity (CBD, 1992) through following measures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use of green infrastructure into the built in environment such as green roof, green garden, permeable pavements that help to filter storm water runoff, reduce heat island and provide habitat for wildlife• Use best management practices to minimize negative impact on the environment. Some common BMPs include erosion and sediment control measures, pollution prevention measures, and wildlife protection measures.• Use of certified forest wood for construction can help reduce impact of construction on forest.• Incorporation of green spaces into developments• Participating in conservation efforts and partnering with organizations that work to protect and restore natural habitat.
