To fulfil energy demand and reduce carbon emissions, following measures are adopted in sustainable construction practices throughout the lifecycle:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Installing PV panels onsite to generate at least 1% of energy consumption and meeting the electricity demand</li><li>● Purchasing at least 200MW of green power that involves the generation of renewable energy certificates to offset carbon footprints.</li><li>● Providing employees with the necessary awareness, education, and training to reduce energy use.</li><li>● Continuously review and improve the energy performance of all the equipment installed.</li><li>● Installing an energy management system to monitor all the installed devices.</li></ul>
