Purpose	The construction and real estate sector consumes considerable amount of materials and generates waste which can be danger to the environment. The purpose of this Policy is to describe the processes involved in the management of waste generated by the company's activities.
Aspects	<p>Waste management includes, monitoring, collection, transport, processing and waste disposal. Responsible management of waste is an essential aspect of sustainable building. Developing a comprehensive policy for managing construction waste is therefore necessary to ensure that all stakeholders are aware of their responsibilities and obligations when it comes to dealing with construction waste. BPTP recognizes the opportunities and benefits of reducing building related waste disposal into landfills and adopted best waste management practices as per Hazardous Waste Management Guidelines, 1989. Wherever possible, these waste can be reduced or diverted through followings objectives:</p> <p>During Construction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Encourage building design that produces less waste through careful planning and considerations.• Monitor and track the amount of waste generated throughout the course of a project.• Specify target diversion rate for the general contractor.• Establish a tracking system to make informed decisions about how to reduce waste in the future. <p>During Operation and Maintenance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Conduct waste stream audit and develop baseline performance for the project.• Specify target for waste re-use, recycling and, diversion for the project to reduce their environmental impact.• Provide collection and composting of non-hazardous waste.



	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Provide separate bins for hazardous waste in all the common area facility.• Encourage a recycle awareness program for all the employees of the organization.
