# Untimely rain, hail may drop wheat yield by 20% in Rohtak

ROHTAK, APRIL 8 The yield of wheat crop in the district is expected to decline by up to 20 per cent as compared to the last rabi season

Agriculture Department officials attribute the decline to the untimely rainfall and hailstorm that lashed the region in the month of March. As per official sources, the area under wheat cultivation in the district was 1.03 lakh hectares in 2022-23, and the average yield of wheat was 41.70

quintals per hectare. The area under wheat cultivation in the district increased to 1.04 lakh hectares in 2023-24, but the average yield of wheat is likely to be about 33 quintals per hectares this year, indicating a decline of nearly 20 per cent. In a communique to the
